



Definition

The National Driver Register (NDR) is a division in the National Center for Statistics and Analysis under the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA). The NDR maintains the computerized database known as the Problem Driver Pointer System (PDPS) which contains information on individuals whose privilege to operate a motor vehicle has been revoked, suspended, canceled or denied or who have been convicted of serious traffic-related offenses. Based on information received as a result of an NDR search, PDPS will "point" the State of Inquiry (SOI) to the State of Record (SOR), where an individual's driver status and history information is maintained. If the NDR returns an adverse status, Info Cubic will add an MVR for the State of Record (if not already ordered) to obtain additional details.

Required for

Between 1987 and 1994, US Air Carrier industry suffered at least 7 fatal commercial airline accidents due to the absence of background checks being conducted on pilots. Reviews later revealed that the Pilots involved had prior safety violations and/or training problems. As a result, Congress passed the Federal Aviation Reauthorization Act of 1996, commonly referred to the Pilot Records Improvement Act of 1996 (PRIA). PRIA Authorizes the mandatory gathering and sharing of records from the FAA and previous employers, which allows an air carrier to make an informed decision before extending a firm offer of employment to a pilot applicant. Turn Around Time

The NDR is required by law to furnish records that have been requested from them, no later than 30 days after receiving the request; however, results are generally received in 1 to 2 business days.

Information Required

- Full Name
- Notarized FAA Form 8060-13

Results Guidelines

Results will include:

- That the NDR does not contain a record matching the candidate; or
- That the NDR has a probable identification (pointer record) from one or more states, which will be named on the report.
